Some of the best producers in Badajoz are privately owned estates with the means to experiment. The oil produced by the Marqués de Valdueza on his 200-ha (494-acre) estate in the Guadiana valley near

Mérida is a good example. The olives are mainly *Arbequina*, *Picual*, and *Hojiblanca* – none of them indigenous to Badajoz – and great attention is paid to good cultivation, prompt processing and correct storage. Marqués de Valdueza oil is widely available in gourmet shops throughout Spain and abroad, and makes a most interesting blend – fragrant, fruity, smooth, lightly peppery, and harmoniously balanced between the different cultivars that go into its composition.
